Background

Lewis Dunlop Boyd was granted a personal licence at the Licensing Board of 13th February 2020.

In terms of section 83 (7) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act the Board must hold a hearing with regard to the conviction.

Board Options

The Board may:

- if satisfied that it is necessary to do so for the purposes any of the licensing objectives, make an order:
 - (i) Revoking
 - (ii) Suspending for such period not exceeding six months as the Board considers appropriate, or
 - (iii) Endorsing the personal licence held
 - take no further action.

The Board must make an order revoking the licence if the Board are satisfied that, having regard to the licensing objectives, the licence holder is not a fit and proper person to be the holder of a personal licence.
