The application requests a terminal hour of 2.30am on Thursday 18th to Saturday 20th July 2024 and refers to 'an event of local or national significance' with the reason given as 'The Golf Open being hosted at Troon'.

At the Board meeting of 16th May 2024, the Board agreed requests for Occasional Licences for the Open Golf Championships and Extended Hours for a premises in Ayr to allow them to cater for people in the area due to the same event. We have also been able to grant similar applications under delegated powers over the last month as these have been within the Board's policy.

Considering the above and the considerable work and investment by both the event organiser and the other partners involved, I believe it is accepted by the Board that the Open Golf Championships is an event of both local and national significance and therefore an acceptable reason to apply for extended hours.

The hours requested are equal to one and a half additional trading hours, which cannot be granted under delegated powers.

As this application reflects hours that have previously been granted to these premises and there are significant plans in place for the Open Golf Championships in the Troon area, I have no objections to the grant of the extended hours requested.
