- 4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom or by electronic transfer of funds (Faster Payment).
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 4 July.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12:00 midnight on Tuesday 18 June.
- 7. New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 9 Wellington Square, Ayr, KA7 1HL, by 17:00 hrs on Wednesday 19 June.
- 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 17:00 hrs on Wednesday 26 June. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
- New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 9 Wellington Square, Ayr, KA7 1HL, by 17:00 hrs on Wednesday 26 June.
- Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at 9 Wellington Square, Ayr, KA7 1HL, by 17:00 hrs on Thursday 4 July.
