


When moving into a facility in Scotland clubs have more than doubled their membership, they experience **rapid growth** in the first 12 months. One club experienced 458% growth.

What is the value of a dedicated facility project to the lo economy?

"Using the Sport England Economic Benefits model, a dedicated gymnastics facility project can give a total **benefit to the local economy in excess of £I million**. This includes GVA (Gross Value Added) and wider benefits such as volunteering and health. Combined with the large increased user numbers, customer demographic and potential for all day use, this makes a dedicated gymnastics space an attractive offer to local authorities. British Gymnastics estimates that the average annual turnover for a dedicated gymnastics facility is around £250,000"




South Ayrshire Average Household Income

## 2016 Gymnast Participant Sessions\*





ASMO Data South Ayrshire The evidenced growth in gymnastics throughout Scotland is mirrored by the clubs 10 years of experience within the sport. We have immediately filled any new class we have added to our program and sustained it over a period of time. Despite continual growth in all areas our waiting lists continue to grow and we are unable to satisfy continual demand.

Membership interest is constant but also spikes during period of major sporting events such as Commonwealth Games, World and European Championships which Glasgow has recently hosted. The public profile of the sports top athletes is also increasing with participation in programmes such as Strictly Come Dancing and Question of Sport again elevating the profile of the sport.

Upcoming coverage of the sport via a new format on Sky Sports will undoubtedly to boost the sport profile even further with an anticipated knock on effect on membership applications. We liaise with our neighbouring clubs and council providers who all report similar membership numbers and an inability to cope with general demand in our local area.

Gymnastics provides key physical literacy skills and for this reason is a compulsory part of the school curriculum maintaining a constant awareness throughout the target market for the sport.
