## **Any Other Competent Business**

Stagecoach Buses - No improvements to bus service. Despite complaints about 1 service in particular the response received from Stagecoach Ayr was blunt. A further complaint was submitted and a response was received from Stagecoach Scotland apologising for the blunt response. Despite this there has been no improvement in the service.

Tutoring Sessions – Still going well and due to proximity of exams additional sessions have been delivered.

Looking to expand subjects next year to include English etc.

Spring/summer planting – Meeting took place with Co-Ordinator from South Ayrshire Council and we are to receive free compost to top up the planters and free plants to assist with the planting. Waiting on date for delivery of these to enable a date to be decided for planting. Hamilton Brothers can assist with the moving of the planters from their location in Ayr Road to other locations in the village.

Tarbolton Landfill – No further information has been provided by SEPA or Scottish Government.

Boy and Girl stones from old Primary. B McColm is trying to find someone to deal with this. Hopefully put in place for the Gala Day.

Community Garden will need to go through the Place Plan so unable to proceed until this has been done. Hopefully be able to take this forward in the future.

Clean up Tarbolton Woods Campaign will return this year. 1<sup>st</sup> day back will be 18<sup>th</sup> May then next day will be in July and a community BBQ later in the summer. Samantha Brown will be liaising with Ayrshire Rivers Trust.

St John's Ambulance will be running Defibrillator training on 15<sup>th</sup> May in the village.



Speed Limits and road conditions – residents urged to report any repairs. Lorries from new development are driving on pavements causing damage. Still waiting on report from ARA re speed reduction measures following recent traffic counts.

The Bachelor's Club has received funding to repair the thatch roof.
