Minutes of a hybrid webcast meeting held on 13 June 2024 at 10.00 a.m.

Opening Remarks

The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting, outlined the procedures for conducting this meeting and advised that it would be broadcast live.

1. <u>Declarations of Interest</u>

There were no declarations of interest by Members of the Board in terms of the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

2. Date of Next Board Meeting

The Chair advised that the next Board meeting would be held on Wednesday 21 August 2024 at 10.00 a.m.

3. Minutes of Previous Meeting

The Minutes of the Meeting of South Ayrshire Licensing Board of 16 May 2024 (issued) were submitted.

Decided: to approve the Minutes of the previous meeting.

4. Update by Licensing Standards Officer (LSO)

The Licensing Standards Officer advised

- (1) that due to the summer months, a number of extra staff members such as students and part time staff had entered the hospitality trade;
- (2) that licence holders were reminded that all staff who worked in licensed premises must have received documented training and to ensure that the records for this could be inspected by the LSO or Police Scotland;
- (3) that to ensure there would be a consistent level of staff training across South Ayrshire and to assist Premises Managers in the delivery of training, a free staff training session had been held in Maybole Town Hall with the training delivered by the LSO;

- (4) that the training session had been attended by 68 delegates from a variety of premises, some of whom indicated they had previously attended training but also some who had not had any training but currently worked in licensed premises. Evaluation of the event showed that everyone who attended stated that they had learned something new. The course was designed to meet the requirements of the mandatory training set out in the regulations had been delivered to include group tasks and discussions. Those who attended the training found this method of delivery preferable to an online session as 66 of the 68 people in attendance commented positively. Premises Managers and those with a personal licence also attended to help for the future when they were responsible for delivering staff training and the event was able to be offered free of charge thanks to the support of forum members David Cuthill and Paul Zive and the water supplied by Bookers Cash and Carry and Tennents; and
- (5) to note that staff from the following venues were in attendance: Ropes (Maidens), Abbotsford Hotel (Ayr), Savoy Park (Ayr), Maidens Bowling Club, Kirkmichael Arms, Kirkmichael Shop & Café, Premier (Maybole), Wildings Restaurant (Maidens), High Society (Maybole), Glenapp Castle (Ballantrae), Kings Arms (Ballantrae), Dailly Bowling Club, The Swee (Girvan), The Carrick (Maybole), Wellingtons (Ayr), Girvan Bowling Club, Souters Inn (Kirkoswald), Bridges Bar (Ayr), The Greenside (Maybole), China Moon (Girvan), Victory Bar (Girvan).

The Chair outlined that he had been able to attend the staff training session at Maybole Town Hall and that he had been pleased with how well supported it had been by the local trade and noted personal thanks to Mrs Andrew, Paul Zive and David Cuttle for their work which made the training a pleasant experience.

Subject: Revocation of Personal Licences

1. Purpose

To advise members on the revocations of personal licences.

2. Recommendation

3. Background

The Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 introduced personal licences. It is a condition of the personal licence that (a) the applicant undertakes refresher training within five years of the date of issue of the licence and (b) no later than 3 months after the expiry of five years from the date of issue produces evidence of the training to the Board. Failure to complete either part of the process means that the Board must revoke the personal licence. (Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 section 87(3)

4. Current Position

Since the last report to the Board, a further 25 personal licences have been revoked under delegated powers. All licence holders affected have been advised by post to their last known address of the revocation of their licences. Revoked licence holders can still take refresher training and then reapply for another personal licence although there is a cost of £50 for the new application. (There is no fee payable if the refresher training is completed and intimated to the Board on time.)







Sprig Ltd – Printhouse, Nile Court, Ayr Extended Hours Application – 25th August 2024 Report by Licensing Standards Officer

I refer to the Extended Hours application submitted for the above premises which is situated in Nile Court in Ayr which is a mixed residential and commercial area.

The application requests a terminal hour of 3.30am on Sunday 25th August 2024 and refers to 'an event of local or national significance' with the reason given as 'Summer Bank Holiday'.

At the Board meeting of 16th January 2020, the Board agreed a report regarding Extended Hours which gave a list of events that in the opinion of South Ayrshire Licensing Board, were of local or national significance and 'August Summer Bank Holiday' was on the list. However the Scottish bank holiday in August is Monday 5th August and therefore I would expect any extended hours application to be for Sunday 4th August.

The applicant has requested extended hours for Sunday 25th August which is the day preceding the summer bank holiday in England (Monday 26th August 2024). This means that patrons are less likely to be on holiday from work the following day as this date is not significant in South Ayrshire or Scotland.

The Board may wish to consider if they wish to grant the extended hours for this date for the reason given by the applicant which has been described as 'an event of local or national significance'.

Sprig Ltd – Printhouse, Nile Court, Ayr Extended Hours Application – 19th, 20th & 21st September 2024 Report by Licensing Standards Officer

I refer to the Extended Hours application submitted for the above premises which is situated in Nile Court in Ayr.

The application requests a terminal hour of 3.30am on the evening of Thursday 19th September (extending into the morning of Friday 20th September) and a terminal hour of 3.30am on Friday 20th April (extending in to the morning of Saturday 21st September) and a terminal hour of 3.30am on Saturday 21st September (extending in to the morning of Sunday 22nd September) and the application refers to the Ayr Gold Cup Festival at Ayr Racecourse. The Ayr Gold Cup is a fixture that was identified by South Ayrshire Licensing Board at its meeting on 16th January 2020 as being of 'local or national significance', however the report refers only to the Saturday as that is the day that hosts the actual Gold Cup race.

Having been present at the pre-planning discussions for the Gold Cup festival, I am aware that Thursday is the opening day and Friday is the ladies day. Both are expected to have a significantly lower attendance than the Gold Cup day on the Saturday.

The Board may wish to consider if they feel that extended hours for 3 days is appropriate or if only the significance of the Saturday race day is a reason for extended hours to allow a 3.30am close.

For comparison, I can confirm that premises have been granted extended hours for local events in South Ayrshire that have attracted audiences of between 3 and 7 thousand people.

Sprig Ltd - Printhouse, Nile Court, Ayr Extended Hours Application - 31st October 2024 Report by Licensing Standards Officer

I refer to the Extended Hours application submitted for the above premises which is situated in Nile Court in Ayr.

The application requests a terminal hour of 3.30am on the evening of Thursday 31st October (extending into the morning of Friday 1st November) and the application refers 'Halloween', which is described by the applicant as 'an event of local or national significance'.

In the past the Board have recognised Halloween as an event of local or national significance and extended hours have been granted to a variety of premises over the past few years. In 2023 extended hours were granted to these premises for the same date for Halloween celebrations.

Although this request for extended hours is for a midweek date rather than the usual weekend applications, the date requested is on Halloween itself and therefore I believe this meets the criteria and indeed the Board's policy. As these premises already has a terminal hour of 2.30am on a Thursday night, the hours requested amount to one additional hour which is within the Boards current policy.

Sprig Ltd – Printhouse, Nile Court, Ayr Extended Hours Application – 2nd November 2024 Report by Licensing Standards Officer

I refer to the Extended Hours application submitted for the above premises which is situated in Nile Court in Ayr.

The application requests a terminal hour of 3.30am on the evening of Saturday 2nd November (extending into the morning of Sunday 3rd November) and the application refers to a 'Halloween Theme Event', which is described by the applicant as 'a special event to be catered for on the premises'.

This applicant has separately requested extended hours on 31st October for their standard Halloween celebration. However, this application is for a specific event which has a Halloween theme but is based on a fully immersive event for which there will be a charge to participate.

In 2023 the Board heard from the applicants representative about the detail of the event which involved actors and scenery to create an atmosphere surrounding a specific story/theme which was different to the annual Halloween celebration held for weekly customers. As a result of the information provided, the extended hours were granted in 2023.
