I am writing regarding the proposed asset transfer of Muirhead activity centre to Dundonald gymnastics club. I strongly oppose this move due to how many classes currently run here, furthermore the after-school club is the only club to service Muirhead primary and Struthers primary school. There are 60+ children who attend this after-school club with a large waiting list of children waiting to get in, it is imperative to people going to work. I use the after-school club and my husband works offshore therefore if this after-school facility was taken away I would have to quit my job. Bear in mind that I work in a unique job in theatres at Crosshouse who recently have advertised three job posts for people who do my job and found no one to fill the spaces. NHS Ayrshire and Arran are already falling behind on budget and surgical waiting times and if I had to quit less people would be able to receive a general anaesthetic. I'm sure my circumstances are similar to a lot of people's in Troon, I am asking you to look at the bigger picture here. I would like to know if the after-school facility would be relocated elsewhere. I would like to keep my job.
