Ayrshire Growth Deal/Monkton Traffic Issues

Update from David Manson ARA- Secretary read out the email sent on 15/05/2024 to MCC

Key Notes:

Traffic calming no further progress ARA has said offer remains to redesign the traffic calming and make application for funding to support this.

Ayrshire Growth Deal – AGD station road by-pass will not be taken forward as a project. ARA completing a report for numerous bodies and until finalised and approved by all parties unable to advise way forward.

Cllr Dettbarn updated that she had a meeting with Kevin Braidwood ARA end of February also another director in attendance. Cul-de-sac for station road is no longer being considered as picture has changed on the Ayrshire Growth Deal.

If back entrance could be opened at Spirit this would help and was discussed and need to persuade directors to be taken up with chief executive and appointment to be held with Jane Corrie new head of ARA

MCC added traffic cameras, humps have been discussed previously. Need a reasoned discussion /conversation with ARA to help build the situation and further address the ongoing traffic issues. Need something to move forward with.
