The Muirhead Activity Centre is a centre for all the community not just a small portion of people who wish to participate in gymnastics.

Will South Ayrshire council still provide the after school club at this location if the asset is given to the gymnastics club?

After school provisions in south Ayrshire are very few and far between, working families like my own are constantly penalised for working and having children- no spaces in school nurseries, expensive private nurseries, few or no after school care clubs that can collect children from school- the whole thing is a nightmare.

If MAC were to be lost to gymnastics, then where do the children go after school?

Also, with the many many new houses being built in Troon, where are all these families going to put their children, where are all the provisions facilitated by the council?

I don't mind paying for these services but we need buildings etc for them to be made available.

A child placement crisis in Troon is in the not too distant future. Provisions must be put in place to be able to cope with the upcoming demand!

I have one child in P1, one in ante-pre but in a private nursery as no space available in Struthers Primary and one more on the way at the end of April.

To let MAC go to a club that barely anyone in the local community will benefit from will be a tragedy!

Childcare needs sorted in South Ayrshire, it would be a moneymaker for the council- focus should be on this.
