AT EDINBURGH the Twenty ninth day of April Nine-  
 teen hundred and Thirty two, between Ten and Ten  
 thirty forenoon, the Disposition underwritten with  
 Warrant of Registration thereon was transmitted by  
 Post and presented by W.J. McManus, Register of  
 Sasines, and is with said Warrant of Registration  
 recorded as follows vizt:- .....

I, George Bruce Faulds, Teacher, Helensburgh, Trus-  
 tee nominated and appointed by Decree of the Lords  
 of Council and Session dated Fifth November Nine-  
 teen hundred and twenty, in Petition by Gilbert Ken-  
 nedy, Farmer, Delamford, Dailly, George Adam, Teac-  
 her, sometime Barr, now at Jackton (therein called  
 "Jackson") Schoolhouse, East Kilbride, John Lambie,  
 (therein called "John Lammie") Barr, me the said  
 George Bruce Faulds, and Reverend Edward Brown,  
 Annbank, Ayrshire, the Trustees nominated and ap-  
 pointed by and acting under the Trust Disposition  
 and Settlement executed by the Reverend John Angus,  
 Minister of the United Free Church of Scotland Con-  
 gregation, Barr, Ayrshire, dated Second September  
 Nineteen hundred and eighteen extracted said Decree  
 on Sixth December Nineteen hundred and twenty and  
 recorded in the Division of the General Register  
 of Sasines applicable to the County of Ayr on Eigh-  
 th December Nineteen hundred and twenty, for the  
 purposes therein mentioned and hereinafter describ-  
 ed, acting with the consent of the said Gilbert  
 Kennedy, George Adam, John Lambie, of me the said  
 George Bruce Faulds and of the said Reverend Edward

Brown as Trustees foresaid CONSIDERING that it  
 has been agreed by the said Gilbert Kennedy, George  
 Adam, John Lambie and Reverend Edward Brown and  
 by me the said George Bruce Faulds as Trustees fore-  
 said that the said ground and Institute <sup>of</sup> be hand-  
 ed over to the said Parish Council in trust for  
 the Inhabitants of Barr and that the said Parish  
 Council have agreed to accept the transfer to them  
 of said ground and Institute THEREFORE I, the said  
 George Bruce Faulds as Trustee acting under said  
 Decree heritably vest in the subjects hereinafter  
 disposed for the better fulfilment of the trust  
 hereinafter mentioned, but no price being paid  
 therefor DO hereby in virtue of the powers confer-  
 red upon me as Trustee foresaid by Section Thirty  
 of The Local Government (Scotland) Act Eighteen  
 hundred and ninety four with consents foresaid  
 GIVE, GRANT and DISPONE to the Parish Council of  
 the Parish of Barr incorporated under said Local  
 Government (Scotland) Act Eighteen hundred and  
 ninety four in trust for the benefit of the inhab-  
 itants of the Parish of Barr (in the first place)  
 ALL and WHOLE that piece of ground of a triangular  
 shape lying in the Village and Parish of Barr and  
 County of Ayr extending to Three roods and Twenty  
 three poles Imperial Measure or thereby and bound-  
 ed as follows namely:- on the North or Northeast  
 by the road separating the said piece of ground  
 from the Churchyard and feus of part of the Barr  
 Lands: On the West by the road separating it

from the Parish Church and Glebe: And on the Southeast by vacant ground lying between it and the road leading from Penkill to Barr all as delineated and coloured pink on the plan or sketch annexed and subscribed as relative to a Disposition by Douglas Alexander Smith Cuninghame, Esquire of Dinmurchie in the County of Ayr and residing at Fairlie House near Kilmarnock in favour of the said Reverend John Angus dated Twenty fourth May and recorded in the said Division of the General Register of Sasines on Tenth June both in the year Nineteen hundred and eleven; which piece of ground is part and portion of ALL and WHOLE the said Douglas Alexander Smith Cuninghame's lands and estate of Dinmurchie lying within the Parish of Barr, late Bailiary of Carrick and Sheriffdom of Ayr, being the subjects described in the Disposition by William Cathcart Smith Cuninghame Esquire of Caprington in the County of Ayr, in favour of the said Douglas Alexander Smith Cuninghame dated Twenty second and recorded in the said Division of the General Register of Sasines on Twenty third January Eighteen hundred and eighty nine; with the teinds, parsonage and vicarage of the ground before disposed so far as I have right as Trustee under said Decree thereto, and my whole right, title and interest present and future therein as Trustee under said Decree and (in the second place) all my right, title and interest as Trustee under said Decree in and to the piece of ground lying between

the piece of ground before disposed and the said road from Penkill to Barr and in and to the piece of ground between said road and the water of Gregg all as shown within the lines coloured mauve on the said plan or sketch: With entry at the date hereof: And I, as Trustee under said Decree, with consent foresaid assign the Writs and have delivered said Disposition in favour of the said Reverend John Angus and said Decree in my favour and in respect the other writs of or relating to said subjects are not in my possession I assign all right competent to me as Trustee under said Decree to demand exhibition or delivery thereof: And I as Trustee under said Decree with consents foresaid assign the rents: And I as Trustee under said Decree grant warrandice from my own proper facts and deeds only and the Consenters hereto as Trustees foresaid grant warrandice from fact and deed only: And I the said George Bruce Faulds as Trustee under said Decree with consents foresaid consent to registration hereof for preservation: IN WITNESS WHEREOF these presents typewritten on this and the two preceding pages, are (under the declaration that the word "entry" occurring on the Twenty ninth line of page second hereof is typewritten on an erasure) subscribed as follows videlicet:— by me the said George Bruce Faulds at Helensburgh on the Fifteenth day of August Nineteen hundred and twenty one, before these witnesses James Ballingall, Inspector of Poor for the Parish of Row,

 and being part of the Lands of Greenan and extend-  
 ing to Twenty three poles or thereby Imperial Stan-  
 dard Measure and bounded as follows videlicet:- on
