There were 122 incidents raised on Police Scotland Reporting system during this period.

In relation the ward priorities the incidents raised/reported were as follows:

Drug Misuse: 4 x Incidents

Road Safety: 13 x Incidents

Dishonesty: 5 x Incidents

Violent Crime: 6 x Incidents

Community Safety: 8 x Incidents

The remainder of the calls relate to alarm activations, pest control, information/assistance calls, assist other agencies and duplicate calls. There were 36 x crime reports raised during the period: Assaults x 4 Disturbances (Breach of the Peace) x 4 Threatening/Abusive towards Retail Workers x 1 Thefts x 3 Vandalisms x 3 Frauds x 2 Drug Offences x 4 (1 x possession of cocaine & 3 x possession of cannabis) Drink/Drug Driving offences x 6 Road Traffic Offences x 7 Assaulting Police Officers/Resisting Arrest x 2
