## **INTRODUCTION**

South Ayrshire Council has a requirement to appoint a suitably experienced, licensed and competent Funfair provider with a high standard of customer service to provide a range of Funfair Rides and Attractions at Ayr's High Street on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2025 for the Christmas Lights Switch On event.

The Christmas Lights Switch On event will begin at 13:00 and finish at 17:30.

## **LOCATION**

The funfair will take place on Ayr's High Street.

## **SERVICES**

The operator will be responsible for providing any power required for the operation of the funfair as well as meeting the cost of all electricity, diesel or any other energy or fuel consumed in the course of the event.

## **USE**

The area on High Street, Ayr will be used for a funfair and no other purpose. The sale of cigarettes and/or alcohol will not be permitted. A fair and affordable pricing structure for each of the proposed rides is required and must remain fixed for the duration of the event, pricing must not fluctuate. The prices submitted are contractual and must be held by the successful Funfair Provider to be charged during the event.

The Fun Fair Operator would be required to play music within the Fun Fair area. The volume of this music must be kept low enough for announcements to be heard and also allow other elements of the event to continue without disruption. Should the provider be requested to lower music levels at any point during the event, they must comply immediately.

South Ayrshire Council has a duty to secure best value services. This means we have to ensure the services provided are high quality, cost effective and meet the needs of local people.

## **LICENCE**

A copy of the Council's standard terms and conditions which the operator will have to adhere to are available on request. The Council will apply for a public entertainment licence covering the full event.

## RENTAL

Rental offers exclusive of VAT, are invited. South Ayrshire Council will not charge VAT on this rental.

## PROFESSIONAL FEES

The operator will be responsible for the Council's reasonable costs and fees incurred in putting in place this agreement.

## OFFERS

Rental offers over £750 are invited for this Funfair opportunity. A closing date for rental offers may be fixed and prospective operators are advised to register their interest by e-mailing the Council's Estates Section.

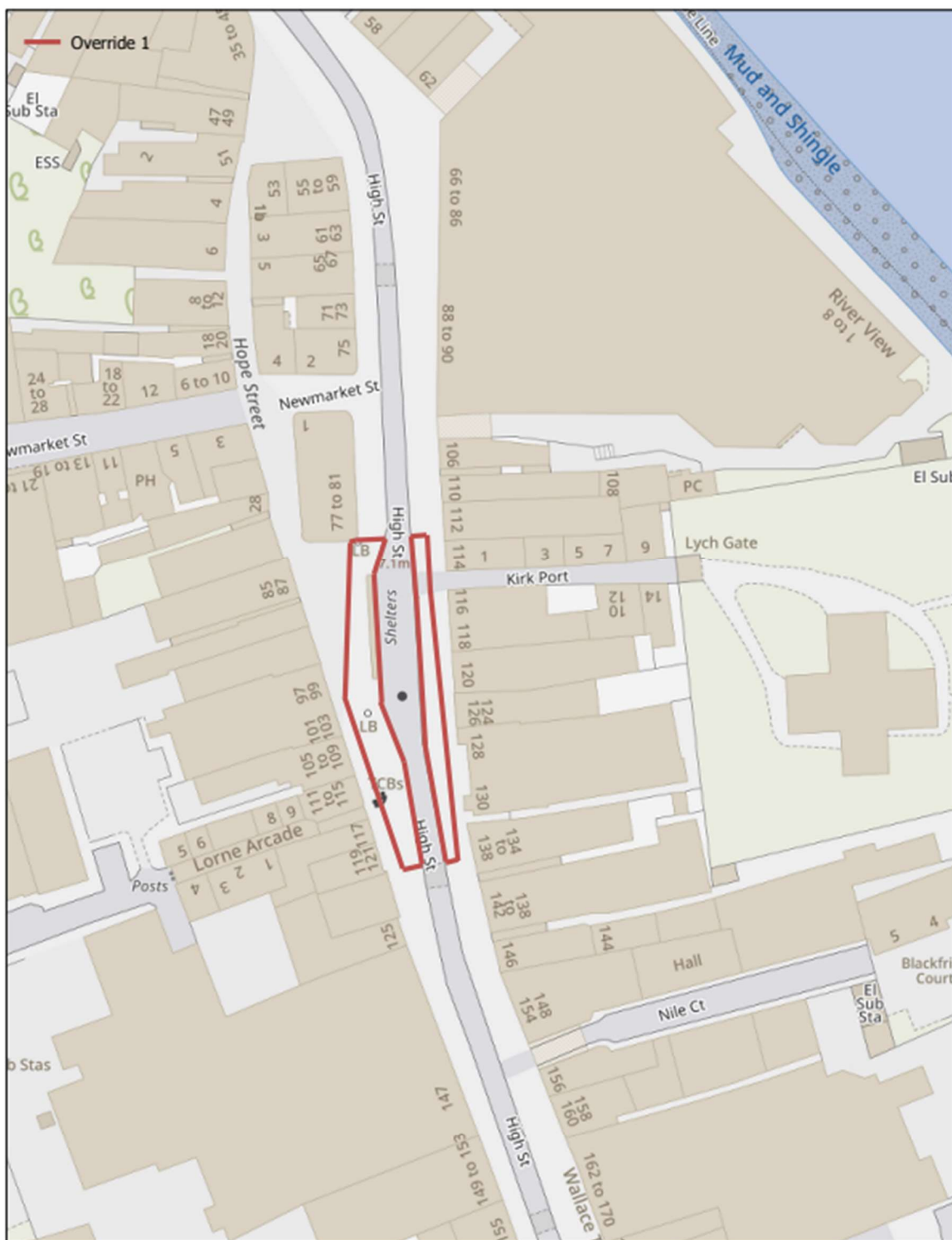
