## **Councillor's Report**

The Provost is pushing ARA for the resurfacing of the southern road out of the village and the problem with the southern chicanes to be addressed. TC spotted an ARA vehicle measuring the road, which may be an indication of progress.

The pavement repairs at the Scottish Water field are costing upwards of £220,000 and are progressing well.

Money has been put aside for replanting at the labyrinth.

The proposed footbridge in the park is out for tender, again.

## **AOCB**

NS reported the lights near the southern chicanes are out and the damaged light at the top of Harbour Brae is still to be repaired. IC will report to ARA.

NS applied to NCCBC for funding to cover a system for the hall to assist with the poor acoustics and people who struggle with their hearing. The application was successful. He hopes to have it in place for the next meeting.
