

SECTION A: GENERAL INFORMATION

1. INTRODUCTION

The Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA) requires Scottish public authorities to produce and maintain a Publication Scheme. Authorities are under a legal obligation to:

- Publish the Classes of Information that they make routinely available, and
- Tell the public how to access the information and whether the information is available free of charge or a payment is required

FOISA allows for the development of Model Publication Schemes which can be adopted by more than one Authority. FOISA provides individuals with a right of access to all recorded information held by Scotland's public authorities. Anyone can use this right, and information can only be withheld where FOISA expressly permits it.

2. ABOUT THIS SCHEME

This Single Model Publication Scheme (MPS) has been approved by the Scottish Information Commissioner (the Commissioner), who is responsible for enforcing FOISA. We are also obliged to review this Scheme from time to time. South Ayrshire Council (the Council) has adopted the single MPS. The detailed MPS can be accessed on the Scottish Information Commissioner's web-site at: Scottish Information Commissioner Model Publication Scheme.

Alongside FOISA, the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (the EIRs) provide a separate right of access to the environmental information that we hold. This MPS also contains details of the environmental information that we routinely make available.

Where information is not published under the MPS, you can request it from us under FOISA or, in the case of environmental information, the EIRs. For further information on accessing information not covered by this scheme, refer to Item 9 – How to Access Information not in the Publication Scheme, below.

3. ADOPTING THE MODEL PUBLICATION SCHEME (MPS)

The MPS can be adopted only in its entirety, without amendment, and commits an authority to:

- **Publish the Information**, including environmental information, that it holds and which falls within the classes of information detailed below, and
- **Produce a Guide** for the public to that information, to guide you through the range of information the Council routinely publishes.

The Commissioner has issued Guidance to accompany this MPS which is available at: Scottish Information Commissioner MPS Guide. This Guide is essential for authorities adopting the MPS as it explains the above requirements in greater detail and lists the types of information the Commissioner expects authorities to publish under each class of information.

5. HOW THIS GUIDE IS FORMULATED

In formulating this Guide, the Council has had regard to the guidance issued by the Commissioner under Section 43(2) of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, and in particular it has undertaken a review of relevant information that can be included in the Scheme, such as leaflets, policy documents and information on the Council's web site. The Council also considered most frequently asked questions, and reviewed the types of enquiries received.

6. RECORDS MANAGEMENT POLICY

South Ayrshire Council is required under the Public Records (Scotland) Act 2011, Section 53 of the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994 and in terms of the Code of Practice on Records Management issued under Section 61 of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 to make proper arrangements for the preservation and management of its records.

To ensure that records are managed effectively, the Council has adopted a Records Policy as part of its records management programme detailing how it intends to manage its records. This relates to all areas of record keeping, including record creation, tracking, storage, retrieval, retention periods and disposal. This Policy details the Council's commitment to ensuring that records are accurate and reliable, can be retrieved easily and are kept for no longer than is absolutely necessary. 7. ROLE OF THE SCOTTISH INFORMATION COMMISSIONER

The Commissioner is responsible for enforcing and promoting the right to access information held by public authorities, created by FOISA 2002 and the EIRs both of which came into force on 1 January 2005. FOISA and the EIRs give *anyone*, *anywhere in the world*, important rights to access the information held by more than 10,000 public authorities in Scotland.

10. GUIDE TO INFORMATION

This document is South Ayrshire Council's Guide to Information. An Authority adopting the MPS must produce a Guide to the Information it publishes through the Scheme. The Authority can decide on the specific format of its Guide to Information.

The Council's Guide to Information must:

- Allow the public to see what information is available, and what is not available, in relation to each Information Class
- State what charges may be applied to access information
- Explain how to find the information easily
- Provide contact details for enquiries, and help users with access to the information
- Explain how to request information that has not been published

Model Publication Scheme Principles

Principle 1 – Availability and Format

Information available under our publication scheme will normally be available through the routes described below. This Guide also provides more details on the information available under the Scheme, along with additional guidance, where relevant, on how the information can be accessed.

Online:

Most of the information listed in our Guide to Information is available to download from the Council's website at www.south-ayrshire.gov.uk. In such instances, where possible, a hyperlink will be listed to direct you to the relevant page or document.

If no links are provided you can use our website's "Search" facility, contact the Council Department using the contact details provided or get in touch with the Council's Freedom of Information Team on (01292) 612223, FOI@south-ayrshire.gov.uk for advice and assistance.

By E-mail:

If the information you seek is listed in this Guide to Information but is not available on the website, we will send it to you by e-mail, if practicable.

If you wish to submit a request by e-mail, please click on the E-mail Address shown against the information you wish to see or contact the Freedom of Information Team (FOI@southayrshire.gov.uk) for further assistance.

By Telephone:

Information can be requested over the telephone. Please provide full contact details, including a telephone number, so that we can clarify any details if necessary. When writing to us to request information, please include your name and address, full details of the information or documents you would like to receive, and any fee applicable (see Item 11: What Charges May Be Applied). Please also include a telephone number so we can contact you to clarify any details, if necessary.

If you require information in a particular format, for example requiring a copy in larger print, Braille, another language or audio cassette, the Council will take all reasonable steps to meet your request.

If the information you are seeking is not available in with Guide to Information, then you may wish to request it from us. FOISA provides you with a general right of access to the information we hold, subject to certain exemptions.

The EIRs provide a right of access to the environmental information we hold, and the Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA) provides a right of access to any personal information about you that we hold. Again, these rights are subject to certain exceptions or exemptions.

Together these three pieces of legislation provide rights of access to most information held by the Council. However, there are other acts or regulations which provide a right of access to specific types of information held by local authorities, or which require registers to be publicly available. Should you wish to request a copy of any information that we hold that is not available under this scheme, please write to the Freedom of Information Officer, contact details listed above.

FOISA does not confer any rights on you as an individual to obtain copies of the information that the Council holds about you personally. However, such personal information (known as "personal data") is covered by the General Data Protection Regulation 2016 (GDPR) as supplemented by the Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA).

The Data Protection legislation gives living individuals the right to a copy of any personal data held by a public authority about them (subject to exemptions such as where disclosure could prejudice a criminal investigation).

Principle 2 – Exempt Information

In maintaining this Guide it is the intention of the Council to be as open as possible. There may, however, be circumstances where information will be withheld from the Classes listed within this Guide to Information. The information withheld may consist of an entire document, or just part or parts of a document. Information will only be withheld where the FOISA expressly permits it.

Information may be withheld, for example, where we consider that disclosure may prejudice substantially law enforcement, legal proceedings, or our regulatory or enforcement activity, or where disclosure is otherwise prohibited by law. We may also withhold information which is confidential or the release of which may prejudice substantially the commercial interests of any person or organisation, including the Council.

Information may also be withheld if it is personal information about individuals and its release would breach the data protection principles contained in the GDPR/DPA. Please note that FOISA does not create any right to see information which the Licensing Board holds about you. However, you do have the right to see this information under the GDPR/DPA – please see Item 12: How to Access Information not in the Publication Scheme, below.

Whenever information is withheld, we will inform you of this, and will explain why that information is not being released.

Principle 3 – Copyright and Re-Use

Access to information does not mean that copyright has been waived, nor does it give automatic rights to the recipient to re-use the information. The following information sets out the Council's position on Copyright and the Re-use of information detailed within this Publication Scheme and Guide to Information.

Copyright

The Council owns the copyright in the information contained in this Scheme unless otherwise stated. The information can be copied or reproduced (but not re-used – see below) without formal permission, provided it is copied or reproduced accurately, is not used in a misleading context and provided that the source of the material is identified and the copyright status acknowledged. **The reproduction of the information for commercial purposes is prohibited.**

The Scheme may however contain information where the copyright holder is not South Ayrshire Council. In most cases the copyright holder will be obvious from the documents. In cases where the copyright is unclear, however, it is the responsibility of the person accessing the information to locate and seek the permission of the copyright holder before reproducing the material or in any other way breaching the rights of the copyright holder.

Copyright works made by central government qualify for Crown copyright protection administered by the Office of Public Sector Information (OPSI). Various categories of Crown copyright material can be reproduced without a formal licence. Information about Crown copyright material is available on the website of the Queens Printer for Scotland at www.oqps.gov.uk.

The Council publishes datasets on our website which will be marked explicitly as Open Data. These are available for reuse and are licensed under the terms of the <u>Open Government Licence for Public Sector Information</u>. Further details of these data sets can be found in our Open Data Category of information we publish, below.

Re-use of Public Sector Information

The Re-use of Public Sector Information Regulations 2015 are intended to encourage and make it easier to re-use information produced by public organisations. Under these Regulations the Council looks at the information it holds and whether it can be re-used.

Re-use means the use of information for any purpose other than that for which it was originally produced. For example, this would mean an individual, company or other organisation taking information that we have produced and re-publishing it or using it to produce a new resource.

Access to the information does not mean that copyright has been waived, nor does it give the recipient the right to re-use the information for a commercial purpose. If you intend to re-use information obtained from the scheme, and you are unsure whether you have the right to do so, you are advised to make a request to South Ayrshire Council to re-use the information. Your request will be considered under the Re-use of Public Sector Information Regulations 2015 (RPSIs) for which a charge may be imposed. In the event that a charge is payable, you will be advised what this is and how it has been calculated.

Principle 4 – Charges

Charges for Information which is available under the Scheme:

Unless a charge is otherwise indicated in this Guide, all information contained within our Scheme is available from us free of charge, where it can be downloaded from our website or where it can be sent to you by e-mail. We do not make a charge for inspection of any of the information.

We reserve the right to impose charges for providing information in a paper copy, computer disc or alternative formats. Charges will reflect the actual costs of reproduction and postage to the Council, as set out below. When this applies a "£" sign will appear under the cost heading in the relevant Information Class within this Guide.

In the event that a payment is required for the information, you will be advised of the charge. Information will not be provided to you until payment has been received.

The Council is mindful of its obligations under equality and anti-discrimination legislation when setting charges for alternative formats.

The Council reserves the right to review this rate as part of the annual budget exercise and subsequently seek the Commissioner's approval.

Charges for Information which is not available under the Scheme:

The charges for information which **is** available under this scheme are set out above. If you submit a request to us for information which **is not** available under the Scheme the charges will be based on the following calculations:

- There will be no charge for information requests which cost us £100 or less to process.
- Where information costs between £100 and £600 to provide you may be asked to pay 10% of the cost. That is, if you were to ask for information that cost us £600 to provide, you would be asked to pay £50 calculated on the basis of a waiver for the first £100 and 10% of the remaining £500.
- We are not obliged to respond to requests which will cost us over £600 to process.
- In calculating any fee, staff time will be calculated at actual cost per staff member hourly salary rate to a maximum of £15 per person per hour.
- We do not charge for the time taken to determine whether we hold the information requested or for the time it takes to decide whether the information can be released. Charges may be made for locating, retrieving and providing information to you.
- In the event that we decide to impose a charge we will issue you with notification of the charge (a fees notice) and how it has been calculated. You will have three months from the date of issue of the fees notice in which to decide whether to pay the charge. The information will be provided to you on payment of the charge. If you decide not to proceed with the request there will be no charge to you.

Charges for Environmental Information under the EIRs:

We do not charge for the time taken to determine whether we hold the information that is requested, nor for the time it takes to decide whether the information can be released. Charges may be made for locating, retrieving and providing information to you.

In the event that we decide to impose a charge we will issue you with notification of the charge and how it has been calculated. The information will be provided to you on payment of the charge. If you decide not to proceed with the request there will be no charge to you. Charges are calculated on the basis of the actual cost to the authority of providing the information.

- Photocopying is charged at 10p per A4 sheet for black and white copying, 30p per A4 sheet for colour copying.
- Postage is charged at actual rate for first class mail.
- Staff time is calculated at actual cost per staff member hourly salary rate to a maximum of £15 per person per hour.
- The first £100 worth of information will be provided to you without charge.
- Where information costs between £100 and £600 to provide you will be asked to pay 10% of the cost. That is, if you were to ask for information that cost us £600 to provide, you would be asked to pay £50 - calculated on the basis of a waiver for the first £100 and 10% of the remaining £500.
- Where it would cost more than £600 to provide the information to you, however, we will ask you to pay the full cost of providing the information, with no waiver for any portion of the cost.

Principle 6 – Duration

Information published thought the Guide to Information is usually available for at least the current and previous two financial years. Where previous versions are no longer published, these can be requested from the Council under FOISA or the EIRs.

SECTION B: CLASSES OF INFORMATION

The Scheme is divided into twelve General Classes [indexed below]. These general Classes are then further divided into categories of information that the Council is committed to publishing routinely. A "Class" is basically a group of documents relating to the same subject matter.

Each Class and Category describes the type of information, the format in which it is available, an indication of any charge that may apply, contact details and a web address [if applicable].

For ease of reference, the general Classes and Categories of information included in the publication scheme are subject-based rather than organised to reflect the departmental structure of the Council. The aim of this layout is to make it easier to locate relevant information without having knowledge of the Council's structure.

Section 5 above provides guidance on how to request information not covered by this Scheme.

A Key of the Classes and Categories used by South Ayrshire Council is detailed below:

Key to format symbols used in the scheme:

Electronic : Information can be emailed.

Hard copy : Information available in paper form.

Website : Information available on the Council's website.

Inspection Only : Some information may only be available on inspection at Council Offices.

£ Charge : The Council may charge for the provision of some information. Where

instance to obtain details of any charges.
