For residents, South Ayrshire offers high quality schools. In addition, the area offers further and higher education opportunities at Ayrshire College and the University of the West of Scotland.



OUR TEAM

South Ayrshire Council has a dedicated team who provide comprehensive support to Ukrainians who arrive in South Ayrshire under the UK Government program, Homes for Ukraine and the Scottish Super Sponsor Scheme. Some of our team are from Ukraine, but not all, so please do not expect the person helping you can speak your language, but we will use tools like Google Translate to help communicate with you.

Our team will be with you every step of the way during your stay in South Ayrshire, from temporary accommodation in a hotel to helping match you to a sponsor in the community. Once you have settled in the community, a team member will be assigned to you and keep in touch to ensure your safety and assist with your adaptation.

We also can assist with various other matters such as registering children in educational institutions, applying for school clothing grants, arranging English courses for adults and registration in medical institutions, applying for benefits or pension. South Ayrshire Council, along with the Ukrainian community, organise various events and meetings to foster friendships and personal ties, thereby helping the Ukrainian community to grow and develop.

HOTELS AS TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION

Two hotels are offered as temporary accommodation in South Ayrshire. The hotel is provided depending on the availability of vacant rooms and/or pets. However, moving from one hotel to another is not allowed. As with other local authorities of Scotland, hotels provide breakfast and dinner for Ukrainian guests.

Ukrainian guests are expected to comply with fire safety rules and law enforcement standards. If you leave the hotel for more than 5 days, your room will not be kept for you.

The hotel is responsible for providing proper facilities and service. Thus hotel management (not our team) deals with facilities issues heating, pipe functioning etc.



MEDIUM AND LONG TERM ACCOMMODATION

- Self-contained accommodation is a host's property that does not require you to share a bathroom, entry/exit, catering, or sleeping area with people other than those in your family.
- · Hosted property implies to sharing some facilities with hosting family
- Private let and Social Housing mean a tenancy which is a contract between you and a landlord. It lets you live in a property as long as you pay rent and follow the rules. It also sets out the legal terms and conditions of your tenancy.

MATCHING PRINCIPLES

Our team are responsible for matching guests to accommodation. This does not happen on a first come first served basis, so there may be times someone who has arrived after you will be matched to accommodation before you. The reason this might happen could be due to the type or size of accommodation available, location or other circumstance.

The standard principles our team follow when matching include:

1	 Hosted accommodation will be offered to hotel guests first; Social housing is rare, when Housing Services provide social housing, it will be offered to guests in the community first.
2	Priority will be given to any guests who are living with hosts that have an imminent date hosting arrangements are ending or to somebody who is at risk of being homeless.
3	Equal priority to residents from both hotels.
4	To avoid frequent refusals we work on making reasonable property offers, therefore under the Homes for Ukraine scheme you are expected to accept any reasonable offer. A reasonable offer of accommodation will take in to account the following criteria: • health or disability requirements • suitable size of property to accommodate all household members • availability for at least 6 months • family connections with other Ukrainians living within South Ayrshire • current education enrollment (although this is not a priority and a change of school may be required) • employment (within 90 minutes to get to the workplace from door to door) • time spent in a hotel

WHEN YOU ACCEPT AN OFFER

When you accept an offer to live with a host family or in a social property, we will provide assistance in the following areas:

Support and Security:

We understand that moving frequently within a year can cause stress and uncertainty. That's why our team is committed to ensuring a smooth resettlement for you.

Relocation: We will arrange a taxi to take you from the hotel to your new place.

The host families are carefully vetted to ensure that the space sufficient for quests. Furniture and necessary ac

The host families are carefully vetted to ensure that their home is safe and provides space sufficient for guests. Furniture and necessary accessories will be accessible to guests. You are not supposed to pay any rent or provide free labour. As for utilities or any other important details, we suggest you discuss with your host and make an occupancy agreement (either verbal or written).

Ongoing Support:

Once you leave a hotel, you are not permitted to return. An officer from our team will be assigned to you to ensure your safety and help you adjust to your new surroundings. With your consent, our team member may visit you occasionally. This is to keep in touch with Ukrainians in our community and to keep you informed about events and updates in South Ayrshire. We also use various ways of communication, such as email, phone, messengers, and social networks.

SCHOOL EDUCATION

The education system in South Ayrshire is highly regarded and offers a wide range of educational opportunities for children of all ages.

There are 43 primary schools and eight secondary schools located throughout South Ayrshire, with the largest concentration of schools found in the town of Ayr. These schools provide a high standard of education, with well-trained teachers and modern facilities.

Primary education in South Ayrshire typically starts at the age of four or five, with children attending primary school for seven years. The primary curriculum is broad and balanced, covering a range of subjects, including literacy, numeracy, science, and social studies. There is also a focus on developing key skills such as problem-solving, communication, and critical thinking.

Secondary education in South Ayrshire typically starts at the age of 11 or 12, with children attending secondary school for six years. The secondary curriculum is also broad and balanced, with academic and vocational courses available. Students can choose to specialise in specific subjects or pursue a more general education.

In addition to traditional schools, South Ayrshire also offers alternative education options, such as schools for children with additional needs and community schools for adult learners. If you have school-age children, our team will help to find a place for your child in a nearby school based on their age and location. In some cases, the child may need to use a town or school bus. We also assist families with preschool children in applying to nursery.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES

We understand the importance of English language proficiency for adaptation in Scotland, which greatly facilitates communication with various services, medical staff, and increases employability.

South Ayrshire Council and local organisations offer free English courses for adults, both at the college level for more advanced students and through local organisations for those at a beginner or intermediate level. These courses aim to improve the student's overall English language ability, including speaking, listening, reading, and writing.

Attending an English language course can greatly improve the integration and adaptation of Ukrainians in South Ayrshire. The knowledge of English makes it easier to communicate with local people and institutions, making it easier to settle and establish oneself in a new environment.

HEALTHCARE

The healthcare system in South Ayrshire is provided by the National Health Service (NHS) in Scotland. The NHS is a publicly funded healthcare system that provides medical care and treatment to all residents of Scotland, including those living in South Ayrshire.

VOUCHER AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial support and vouchers are also available. A £200 voucher is provided to each Ukrainian guest who settles for a long-term period in South Ayrshire with a local host family or in social/rented property. Ukrainian guests can also benefit from the social assistance provided by the Scottish Government. If you rent a social or private accommodation, you can take advantage of Housing Benefit support subject to receipt of Universal Credit.

Other benefits, such as Scottish Child Payments, Child Benefits, Universal Credit/Pension Credit etc. are accessible all over Scotland for those who are entitled to.

THINGS TO DO AND SEE IN SOUTH AYRSHIRE
