Chair's Remarks

The Chair

- (1) welcomed everyone to the meeting; and
- (2) outlined the procedures for conducting this meeting and advised that this meeting would be broadcast live.

1. Sederunt and Declarations of Interest.

The Co-ordinator - Licensing called the Sederunt for the meeting and having called the roll, confirmed that there were no declarations of interest by Members of the Panel in terms of Council Standing Order No. 17 and the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

2. Minutes of Previous Meeting

3. Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 - Licences**(a) Taxi Drivers.**

Decided: to approve this application for three years, subject to standard conditions as previously agreed.

Decided: to approve the application for an exemption under section 166 of the Equality Act 2010 and grant this exemption for the duration of Mr MacDougall's current licence and the duration of any future licences held by Mr MacDougall.

(b) Taxi Vehicle.
